The **Islamic Republic of Pakistan** has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development towards the cost of **Punjab Barrages Improvement Phase-II Project** and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for **Replenishing stone in stone apron and inverted filter portions downstream of Jinnah Barrage Damaged During Floods of 2010 (JB/NCB-01). Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits published by the Bank in May 2004 and revised in October 2006.** 

- 2. The Head PMO invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for "Replenishing stone in stone apron and inverted filter portions downstream of Jinnah Barrage Damaged during Floods of 2010. Stone Apron 40'-50' wide in almost entire width downstream of Jinnah Barrage (3781 ft) along-with inverted filter in front of some bays have damaged seriously during super flood 2010. In damaged parts of inverted filter and stone apron, loose stone / stone in wire crates will be dumped in flowing water by boats in a limited period of 60 days".
- 3. Bidding documents (and additional copies) may be purchased at **office of PMO Punjab Barrages**, **Project Offices Building**, **Canal Bank**, **Mustafa-abad** (**Dharampura**) **Lahore** for a nonrefundable fee of **Rs. 5,000/-** (**Rupees Five Thousand only**) for each set. Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same address.
- 4. Bids shall be valid for a period of 30 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by security of at least **2% of bid cost** and shall be delivered to Head PMO on or before **1200 noon on April 04, 2011**, at which time they will be opened in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend.
- 5. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.
- 6. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide a total price. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid.
- 7. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected. A pre-bid meeting will be held on March 24, 2011 (11:00 A.M) at PMO-Punjab Barrages for clarification about the bidding document and scope of works, if any. All the interested contractors are invited to attend the meeting.
- 8. As provided in the bidding documents, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/pooling) will be declared ineligible, either in indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
