Recruitment of Individual Consultant for External Monitoring and Evaluation of the Implementation of Land Acquisition and Resettlement Plan (LARP) for New Khanki Barrage Project

Monitor and assess whether resettlement objectives, particularly livelihoods and living standards of the Affected Persons (APs) have been restored or enhanced.

Overall objectives of the Individual Consultant is to provide high level and professional independent advices and guidance to support PMO objectivity and ensure safe, economical, state-of-the-art construction/installation, and quality assurance/quality control procedures for successful implementation of NKB Project.

Must have master degree in social sciences; anthropology, social/rural development, economics, ets and must demonstrate proven track record of five years or more in monitoring and evaluation of development projects, with focus on resettlement monitoring.
