- 1. The Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development towards the cost of Punjab Barrages Improvement Phase-II Project and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for Procurement and Installation of Real Time Flow Monitoring System on Punjab Irrigation Networks in Punjab (JB/ICB-03/RTFM). Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits published by the Bank in May 2004 and revised in October 2006.
- 2. The Project Management Office (PMO) for Punjab Barrages Rehabilitation and Modernization Projects invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for Procurement and Installation of Real Time Flow Monitoring System (RTFM) on Punjab Irrigation Networks in Punjab (JB/ICB-03/RTFM). This is a fixed price contract and includes but not limited to the design, supply of all components required for completion of integrated RTFM system, installation, testing and commissioning, training to Irrigation staff for operation, and maintenance of the stations and the integrated RTFM system in whole.

The system shall be installed at scattered locations across Eastern Sadiqia Canal systems, heads of all barrages in Punjab, head/tail reaches of main/link canals off-taking from aforesaid barrages inclusive of tailrace of Mangla Powerhouse, Upper Jhelum Canal (UJC), head of Bong Escape and LCC feeder off-taking from QB Link Canal within Punjab Province.

- 3. The bidding documents are available in the office of the undersigned and the same may be obtained subject to the payment of the cost of the printing and provision of the document which is Rs 5,000/- only. Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same address.
- 4. Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by security of at least 2% of bid cost and shall be delivered to Head PMO on or before 1100 hours on March 15, 2016 and will be opened on the same day at 1130 hours in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend.
- 5. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.
- 6. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item listed in BOQ and also provide a total price for whole Contract. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid
- 7. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected. A prebid meeting will be held on February 23, 2016 at 1100 hours at PMO-Punjab Barrages for clarification about the bidding document and scope of works, if any. All the interested contractors are invited to attend the meeting.
